Happy Independence Day!

Greetings in the name of Jesus, Name above all names! This month as we celebrate the blessings of our liberty let us remember and champion this blessed truth: ***Righteousness exalteth a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people (Prov. 14:34).*** As Christians we know that liberty is an exalting blessing from heaven. (***...where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty (2 Cor. 3:17).***) It is also a very precious and fragile gift. It will not remain upon a people set to do evil.

I love this operational description of freedom: *Freedom is not the sanction to do what we please, it is the opportunity to do what we should.* Doing right is the surest way to “secure the blessings of liberty to ourselves and our posterity.” (From the preamble to the US Constitution.)

The timeless words from President Abraham Lincoln’s Gettysburg Address (November 19, 1863) have good instruction for us today: *...[I]n a larger sense, we can not dedicate – we can not consecrate – we can not hallow – this ground. The brave men, living and dead, who struggled here, have consecrated it, far above our poor power to add or detract. ... It is for us the living, rather, to be dedicated here to the unfinished work which they who fought here have thus far so nobly advanced. It is rather for us to be here dedicated to the great task remaining before us – that from these honored dead we take increased devotion to that cause for which they gave the last full measure of devotion – that we here highly resolve that these dead shall not have died in vain...*

May God strengthen us to the holy task of promoting the gospel of Christ. For it is the power of God unto salvation to every person who believes! ***2 Chronicles 16:9 - The eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show Himself strong in the behalf of those whose heart is perfect toward Him...***
